Cost/Ride

- 9-mile, \$10 for each rider. Starts at 10:30 a.m.
- 20-mile, \$25 for each rider. Starts at 10 a.m.
- 31-mile, \$40 for each rider. Starts at 9:30 a.m.
- 62-mile, \$40 for each rider. Starts at 8:30 a.m.

ABOUT THE RIDE

CHOOSE YOUR DISTANCE: The 9-mile route is ideal for youth, families and beginners. A 20-mile course suits riders ready for a bit more distance. Experienced cyclists can choose a 31-mile "Forest and Farmland" circle route through the country or a 62-mile "Kerr Lake Look" that adds to that 31-mile route an out-and-back spur to the lake past the Nutbush Creek State Recreation Area and Bullocksville State Recreation Area.

Rides will start and finish at VGCC's Main Campus, located off Interstate 85 and Poplar Creek Road at 200 Community College Road in Henderson.
